Two years living in Korea made Alexandria jewelry designer Anibel Ng-Conwell fall in love with its mashup of minimalism and maximum-impact style. "Everything [there] is about fashion, from shops in the train stations to residents who have no fear about wearing anything," she says. That passion shines in Ng-Conwell's simple yet sophisticated Egolord line (egolord.com)—think a lightweight but dramatic crinkled silver cuff.
